Subject: 2021 State Softball Information

The Girls State Softball Brackets, as per WHSAA Rule 7.11.57, can be found on the WHSAA website ([www.whsaa.org](http://www.whsaa.org)). The State Tournament will be a double elimination format.

**Softball Team Roster** - Please upload rosters and team pictures to MaxPreps prior to May 7 for possible inclusion in the program. No more than 18 players may be in uniform for any state tournament contest. The 18 players whose names are entered in the official scorebook for the first contest, shall be the only players used for the entire tournament. Violation of this rule will result in a forfeit. Rule 7.11.57.1.

**Locker Rooms** – Please come dressed and ready to play.

**Bus Parking** – Buses can drop off players at the east entrance and will need to park in the east parking lot furthest away from the fields to alleviate traffic congestion. Please See Map. Players scheduled for the upcoming games can warm up on fields 3 and 4.

**Team Packets** – Team packets will be handed out upon arrival at the Energy Capital Sports Complex. Team passes must be presented for admission to the tournament.

**Video Taping** - Provisions will be made for one person from each team involved in the contest to video the game from a vantage point off the level of the field. Please be prepared to use battery power to accomplish this videotaping.

**Hospitality Room** – Due to the location of this event, a hospitality room will not be provided.

**Concessions** – Food concessions will be available.

**State Memorabilia** – State Tournament memorabilia will be available for sale from Fine Designs.

**Athletic Trainers** – There will be a Certified Athletic Trainer on-site in the concession storage room. **Teams need to bring their own water coolers and med kit.** There will be minimal athletic trainer supplies. Also, the Athletic Trainer will be unavailable for 20-minute periods throughout the day. This schedule will be posted.

**Coaches Meeting** – There will be a coaches' meeting at Thunder Basin High School on Thursday, May 20th, at 7:00 pm for all conference/all state in the Business Conference Room. If your coach will not be in attendance, please have them coordinate with Mike DeLancey [mdelancey@ccsd.k12.wy.us](mailto:mdelancey@ccsd.k12.wy.us) for a way to participate prior to May 10th.

**Home and Away** – The home team for the first round games will be the higher seed and placed on the top of the bracket. In subsequent rounds, the home team shall be determined by a coin flip. The home team dugout shall be on the first base side. Rule 7.11.57.2

**Practice Fields** – Practice fields 3 and 4 will be open for teams prior to their game. See map for practice fields.

**Tournament Ball** – The official tournament ball is the Baden Perfection 28SFPY.

**Suspended Games** – Refer to Rules 7.11.57.5 & 7.11.57.6 concerning suspended games and inclement weather procedures that will be used at the tournament.

**Other Playing Rules:** - All Rules in 7.11.55, which were used during the regular season, will be followed during the State Tournament.

**Internet Access** - There is very limited wireless access at the fields.

**Shelter** – Should there be inclement weather, school buses will be used to house teams until next steps are known and communicated.

**Awards** – Trophies will be presented for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place. Individual medals will be presented to the State Champions and Runner-Up teams, 18 medals each. Team awards will be presented following the fourth place, third place, and championship games.
