SCHEDULE

#1 Singles, #2 Singles, and #1 Girls Doubles will be played at Sheridan High
#1 Boys Doubles and #2 Doubles will be played at Thorne-Rider Courts
#3 Doubles will be played at the Kendrick Park Courts on Friday and at Thorne
Rider on Saturday

Bus parking at Sheridan High School will be available Hill Pond Drive, Long Drive, and Mydland Road during school hours on Friday. After school hours on Friday, buses should use Hill Pond Drive as there is a football game that night. Bus Parking is limited at Kendrick Park, but readily available at the Thorne-Rider courts.

ENTRIES

Entries (E13) and Record Report Form (E14) should be emailed by noon, Monday, September 13th to Don Julian at don.julian@scsd2.com. These forms are included with this packet and can be found on the WHSAA website. Brackets will be sent by Tuesday afternoon.

HEAD COACHES MEETING

The Head Coaches meeting will be at 7:00 pm, Thursday, September 16th in the Sheridan High cafeteria. Please note that SHS has a mask mandate within our buildings. Brackets, playing times, locations, and instructions will be reviewed. We will have food available for the coaches.

TOURNAMENT RULES

Rules established by the United States Tennis Association shall prevail, except where modified by the WHSAA. Once play has begun in a match, it will be continuous with no breaks unless permitted by the referee (site director). The site director shall have authority to appoint service and line officials as deemed necessary.

SEEDING (WHSAA rule 7.13.44)

The top four schools will be seeded in each bracket. Priority will be given to those schools who have won the most league matches in that bracket. If a tie occurs, the tournament director will use the following criteria:

1. Head to head competition on a two way tie.
2. One school beating others on a three way tie and then head to head competition between the other two.
3. If the tie still exists or cannot be decided with the criteria above, the USTA Friend at Court Handbook of Rules and Regulations, tie breaker procedure will be used to determine the outcome. USTA Regulations II.b.6(c).
4. Coin flip, odd school receives highest seed and then head to head competition between the others.

SEEDING PLACEMENT

The number one and four seeds will always be in the same half of the bracket. The number two and three seeds will always be in the same half of the bracket.

DRAW FOR BYES

If there is one bye, the #1 seed shall have the option of accepting the bye or passing it to the #2 seed. If there is more than one bye, the #1 seed will receive the first bye, the #2 seed will receive the second bye, etc. until all byes are placed. After all seeded players and byes have been placed, the remaining positions will be drawn.

COACHING

Coaching may take place before the match and at the end of each set (up to one minute at the end of set 1, and up to 10 minutes at the end of set 2, if split set). Players may receive coaching from their coaches and/or teammates with the number of persons coaching limited to two per visit. (WHSAA Rule 7.13.33) Coaches are reminded that they are responsible for their team's actions on and around the court and also the actions of any spectators from their respective schools. Do not intentionally interrupt concentration or play in any way.

WARM-UP

A ten (10) minute warm-up will be given before the first match. Athletes will be given up to thirty (30) minutes between back-to-back matches.

MATCH PLAY

Only first round matches each day will be assigned court location and starting times. All other matches will not be assigned to specific courts and times. Athletes should be ready to play as courts become available. Players need to keep track of speed of play at the location they are assigned. It is the players responsibility to be ready when the court becomes available. Players must check in personally with the site director in advance of playing time and be ready to play. Default is the penalty for failure to report.

WINNERS

The winner of a match must win two (2) out of three (3) sets. Sets that are tied at 6-6 will employ a twelve (12) point tiebreaker.

AWARDS

All Conference awards will be provided by the Wyoming 4A League and all Regional awards will be provided by the WHSAA. Regional awards will be presented at the SHS courts at the conclusion of the championship matches.

Conference Awards

- Plaques presented to Boys Team Champion and Girls Team Champion
- All Conference medals presented to First and Second place finishers in #1 Singles, #2 Singles and #1 Doubles
- All Conference medals presented to First place in #2 Doubles and #3 Doubles

Regional Awards

- Name plates presented to First, Second and Third place Boys and Girls Teams
- Medals presented to top four finishers in each bracket.

COACH OF THE YEAR

Conference Girls Coach of the Year and Conference Boys Coach of the Year will be selected at the Regional Tournament. *Please turn in your vote by noon on Saturday, September 18 to Don Julian.* This form is included with this packet.

HOSPITALITY

Lunches will be provided to tennis coaches.

EQUIPMENT

Each coach is asked to bring one squeegee in case of rain. Courts will be assigned at the Coaches meeting.

TENNIS ETIQUETTE

In order to encourage better sportsmanship, tennis etiquette will be strictly enforced. Proper tennis attire, which excludes jeans, cut-off jeans and the like is mandatory. Team shirts will be worn that are appropriate as a member of a school team uniform. Improper language or other acts that detract from the game of tennis will be dealt with by the two coaches or the tournament directors. Disciplinary action could result in forfeiture of a game, set, or match. (WHSAA Rule 7.13.32)
