Entries: Each school is allowed to enter two athletes per weight class. All entries must be entered into Track Wrestling Thursday 2/18/2021 by 12:01 p.m. Seeding information for each wrestler is due by 8:00 am on Friday 2/19/2021 at 8:00 a.m. A team picture and roster should be sent for the virtual program.

Locker Rooms: Each team will have a locker room assigned to them. Please do not leave any valuables as Douglas High School is not responsible for lost items. Towels will not be provided.

Weigh-ins: 12:00 p.m. in the back gym

Seeding Meeting: 12:00 p.m. in the upper auditorium

Seeding Criteria: WHSAA 7.16.71

1. Head to head competition
2. Record against common opponents
3. Returning state placers at any weight (order of place)
4. Best overall record (minimum of ten varsity matches)
5. Coin flip
6. Wrestlers that are not seeded will be randomly drawn into the bracket.
7. Once seeding begins for each weight class, a wrestler may not be taken off the board for consideration

Setup: Two mats will be used for the entirety of the tournament. Table workers will be provided by Douglas High School. Teams will be required to handle blood and bodily fluid issues for their own team. Clean-up supplies will be provided mat side.

Schedule: Wrestling begins at 1:00 p.m. We will have a rolling schedule with small breaks to provide time for cleaning mats and official breaks.

Awards: Awards will be presented to the 1st and 2nd place wrestlers on the mat immediately following the championship match.

Admission: Wrestlers, managers, and coaches will be provided tournament passes. Each school will be provided 100 tickets to pre-sell to allow for family members to be guaranteed entry. Media with proper credentials will be allowed in at no charge. All matches will be on the NFHS Video Network. A subscription must be purchased to view the tournament live.

Regional Tournament Pass: As set by the WHSAA, Adults \$6.00 Students \$4.00

Food: Due to COVID-19 protocols, there will not be concessions or a hospitality room. Food and drink are not allowed in the gymnasium. Schools will be provided an area for a team camp in the back gym where they can have their coolers. Please make sure these areas are monitored and kept clean.
