Tournament Passes

Each team will receive the following passes for the tournament: 12 player passes, 2 manager passes, 3 coach passes, 1 bus driver pass, and 3 spouse passes.

Games

All games will be played at the LVHS Fieldhouse or Aux Gym. Games will not be started early.

Webcasts

All games in the Fieldhouse and the Aux Gym will be streamed on the NFHS Network. Any live telecasts or video replays are subject to rights fees established by the WHSAA Board of Directors. Please let me know if anyone is planning on streaming games.

Home Team

The team on top of the bracket will be the home team and sit to the right of the scorer's table as you face it. Brackets are on the WHSAA website.

Cheerleaders and Pep Bands

Please let me know if you plan to bring cheerleaders or a pep band.

Rosters

WHSAA Rule 7.15.61: No more than twelve players can be in uniform for any contest. The twelve players whose names are entered on the official scorebook for the first tournament contest, shall be the only players used for the entire tournament. Violation of this provision shall cause forfeiture as per WHSAA Rules 5.07 and 1.4.0.

Pregame Warmup

There will be a minimum of a ten minute warm-up. Please do not take the floor before it has been swept. No one will be allowed on the gym floor at half-times.

Videotaping

An area for videotaping will be provided for filming on the west or east side cat walks. You will need to provide your own extension cord.

Locker Rooms

Locker Rooms will be assigned, but also shared. Please take belongings with you. Fremont County School District 1 will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. Towels will not be provided.

Water

Water will not be provided. Water containers must be screw-top or snap-on lids and must be non-glass. There are filling stations by each gym entrance.

Hospitality Room and Concessions

Both will be available.

Training Room

The training room will be available throughout the tournament. Please bring your own supplies.

Bus Parking

Please unload your athletes at the south gym doors. Please park buses directly west of the soccer fields or the south end of the same parking lot. Please keep buses locked or supervised at all times.

Banners/Noisemakers

Banners, signs and artificial noisemakers are not allowed at the tournament site. Please remind your fans.

Bands

Bands are allowed to play at regional and state culminating events. Please let me know in advance if your band intends to play. Just a reminder, they are not allowed to play during live ball situations or free throws.

Dance Teams

Please let me know if your dance team would like to perform at halftime of a game.

Officials

Officials are assigned by the WHSAA.

Awards

Awards will be presented immediately following the award games. Name plates will be awarded to teams finishing in the top four. Individual medals will be awarded to the 1A West Regional Champions. All awards are provided by the WHSAA.

Game Management

Each School is expected to provide an administrator for supervision during each of their games. FCSD1 is not responsible for crowd control. An administrator (or appointee) for each participating teams needs to be present in their fans' section to deal with immediate crowd control issues.
