All-Conference Selection

- All-Conference selections will happen on Thursday, March 6th in the Culinary room; room 101. We will meet in the cafeteria and walk to the meeting room together. The girls' All-Conference meeting will be held after the girls' 4:30 game. The boys' All-Conference meeting will be held after the boys' 7:30 game. The meetings will begin when each school is represented. The meetings will be conducted by Absaraka Conference AD's. We will have you submit your nominations on a Google form. The link will be sent out closer to the tournament date.

Awards

- Awards will be presented immediately following the games that determine third and first place. The first four teams will be recognized and presented with a plate for their regional plaque. Twelve individual medals will be presented to the championship teams. Both regional champions will also be presented with the Absaraka Conference traveling trophy. **2024 Regional Champions - Please remember to bring the traveling trophies with you to the tournament.**

Bands/Cheerleaders

- Due to limited space in the gym, we **WILL NOT** be able to accommodate bands.
- Due to limited space in the gym, we **WILL NOT** be able to accommodate cheerleaders.

Banners/Noise Makers

- Signs made of non-rigid materials such as styrofoam, cloth, or paper **ARE** permitted. Signs may be no larger than can be held by one person. Sign or flag supports made of rigid materials such as wooden dowels, paint paddles, golf club shafts, etc. **WILL NOT BE** allowed. Artificial noise-makers such as air horns, megaphones, cowbells, sirens, clackers, etc. are **NOT PERMITTED** in the gym. Unusual noise at any activity that is created by fans or participants that interferes with the competition or enjoyment of other fans is prohibited. **Glenrock High School reserves** the right to **remove any item or person** that is causing disruption to the game or is deemed unsportsmanlike in nature. **Attendance is a PRIVILEGE** - please help in getting this information to your parents and fans planning to attend the tournament.

Benches/Home-Visitor

- The top team on the bracket will be the **HOME** team on the bench and the scoreboard and will wear **WHITE** jerseys. As you look at the score table, the **HOME** team will sit on the **right-hand (South)** side and the **VISITING** team on the **left-hand (North)** side.

Bus Parking / Drop-off / Pick-up locations

- Teams can enter campus using the football stadium parking area. Travel along the south side of the main HS parking lot and enter through the sliding gate. Team drop-off and pick-up will be at the southwest door of the gym, next to the weight room. There will be signage on the door for entering and exiting the building. Parking will be along the fence on the east side of the stadium. **(Map is attached)**

Concessions / Hospitality Room

- Concessions will be provided.
- We will have a hospitality room for coaches, officials, tournament workers, school administrators, bus drivers, and spouses in the Staff Lounge.

Locker Rooms

- We will assign locker rooms for teams. Glenrock High School and Absaraka Conference **will not** be responsible for theft. Please make sure you secure your valuables. Towels **will not** be provided. Chairs and a whiteboard will be available in each locker room.

Net Removal

- Nets may not be removed after any tournament game per WHSAA rule.

Officials

- Tournament officials are assigned by the WHSAA.

Tournament Passes

- Tournament packets will be presented on your initial visit.
- Your packet will include (12) player wristbands, (3) manager wristbands, (3) coaches wristbands, and (1) bus driver wristband.

Pre-game Warm-up

- You will be guaranteed at least a (10) ten-minute warm-up prior to each game.
- Games will not start earlier than the scheduled start time.
- **No Warm-ups will be allowed during the halftime of the previous game.**

Walk-Throughs / Practices

- Your team may schedule our middle school gym for walk-throughs / practices.
- 60-minute time slots will be allotted.

- There will be wireless internet available in the gym.

Rosters

- Your team roster should be entered into the official scorebook at least **(10) ten minutes prior to your first game**. This roster may include no more than **(12) twelve names**. No more than **(12) twelve players** may be in uniform during any game.
- Your team roster **may not change** once it is officially entered into the scorebook for your first game.

Sportsmanship

- Spectators, students, teams, and coaches are **expected** to display good sportsmanship.
- Each school is responsible for its spectators, students, teams, and coaches.
- It is **expected** that an administrator from each school is present to control their crowd.
- Spectators displaying poor sportsmanship may be asked to leave the facility.

Alcohol and Tobacco-Free Campus

- **NO** alcohol or tobacco products are allowed on campus - **USE** is prohibited on **ALL** school property.

Trainer

- There will be a trainer/EMT on site. More information will be provided at a later date.

Streaming

- All games will be streamed on the NFHS network. Spectators must purchase a pass online to watch streamed games.

Uniforms

- The **TOP** team in each bracket will be designated the **HOME** team and will wear **WHITE** jerseys.
- The **BOTTOM** team in each bracket will be designated the **VISITOR** team and will wear **DARK** jerseys.

Warm-Up Basketballs

- Warm-up basketballs **WILL NOT** be provided. You must bring your own.

Video Taping

- Schools are allowed to videotape their games. All equipment must be set up in the designated area located behind the scorers' table.

Water

- Water will be provided next to each bench.

3rd and 4th Place Games

- These games will only be played if the (2) two teams have not already played during the tournament.
- If the (2) two teams have previously played, the winner of that contest will be the #3 seed and the loser will be the #4 seed.
- Games will be listed on the bracket at "IF NECESSARY".

Ticketing and Pricing

- **Please note and inform your fans that we will be using "GoFan" as our ticketing system.**
- Fans can purchase a "Day pass" (**good for each day**) or a "Tournament pass" (**good for the entire weekend**). More information will be provided in the coming weeks for purchasing instructions.
- Prices are as follows:
 - Tournament Passes - \$13 for Adults; \$10 for Students
 - Daily Passes - \$5 for Adults; \$4 for Students
