Dress Code:	Per WHSAA Rules – Collared Shirt, No Metal Spikes, No Jeans, Hats must be worn facing forward
Practice Round:	Call Kendrick Golf Course (307) 674-8148 to schedule a practice round on Thursday September 19, 2024. The cost will be \$15 per golfer and \$20 per seat if using a cart.
Phones:	Golf apps only. Violations will cause possible disqualification.
Live Scoring:	We will be using the iwanamaker app that provides live scoring for fans. Fans can purchase a subscription by downloading the app from the google play store or apple store on your smartphone.
Pro Shop:	The Pro Shop will be open to all golfers, coaches and spectators to purchase equipment, snacks and drinks.
Markers:	Please refer to the schedule for assignments. Markers will be assigned for each group to ensure accurate scoring.

Awards:	The top 10 individual boys and girls will receive a medal as State The winning boys and girls as well as runners up teams will receive a plaque. Awards will be presented at the end of play on Saturday. As per WHSAA Rule 7.8.68 in case of a tie in the team event (1st, 2nd, or 3rd), or in case of a tie for first place in the individual standings, the tie will be broken by a sudden death playoff.
Coaches Meeting:	There will be a coaches meeting at 10:00 on Sat. the 21st.
Entries:	Please submit your entries on iwanamaker by midnight on Tuesday Sept. 17th. First round pairings will be set on Wednesday Sept 18th. Event names are "2024 2A Girls State Championship" and "2024 2A Boys State Championship".
Hospitality:	Hospitality will be provided to coaches, bus drivers and tournament officials.
Weather:	Discontinuance of Play: The Committee will sound a horn due to weather delays. Please be advised that all Competitors will immediately stop play and take shelter or proceed to Clubhouse after marking ball position. See WHSAA rule policy regarding a complete stoppage in play.
Spectators:	All spectators must check-in at the clubhouse prior to spectating on the course. All spectators will adhere to the WHSAA guidelines.
Tees:	Boys will play white tees, Girls will play yellow tees.
Equipment:	Each Player should bring their own clubs, balls, tees, pencils, ball markers and sharpies.
Markers:	Markers will be provided for each pairing.
Carts:	Carts will be available for markers.
Warm-Up:	The driving range and practice greens will be provided the week of the state tournament.

# Spectators:

7.8.76 SPECTATORS ON THE COURSE DURING TOURNAMENT PLAY

- As spectators enter the tournament venue they will be given a list of Wyoming High School golf "spectator guidelines" and be required to sign-in (indicating they understand the rules and risk). Lanyards will be made available with policy so spectators can visibly display that they have agreed to the guidelines. This will be done on all tournament days. Coaches are expected to share these guidelines with spectators and fans from their school.
- 2. No spectator carts are allowed on the course with the following exception: If a spectator has a disabling condition they may rent a cart from the pro shop but will not be allowed to carry another spectator in that cart. Questions of disabling conditions and carts will be handled by the tournament director.

- **3.** Spectators MUST remain in designated viewing areas, on the cart paths or at least 25 yards from all contestants at all times. Spectators are not allowed on the tee or greens at any time. **Tournament directors reserve the right to not allow spectators on their course at any time.**
- 4. Spectators are specifically instructed not to give any advice or rulings with players. Any verbal and non-verbal contact could be construed as giving advice (Rule 8). Therefore, conversations with players in any form are not permitted. A two (2) stroke penalty may be assessed by the Rules Committee for violation. Spectators may assist in searching for golf balls to help speed up pace of play.
- 5. Spectators must understand there is a risk of injury and assume that risk while they are on or near the golf course.
- 6. Cell phones must be set on silent and cannot be used to communicate with any player.
- **7.** Coaches will be available to monitor and enforce spectator rules, as part of the tournament staff, determined by the meet director.

\* Enforcement of this policy will be implemented as follows: 1st offense – verbal warning; 2nd offense – the spectator will be asked to leave the golf course.

For a serious breach of the spectator policy, decisions on future suspensions will be left to the discretion of WHSAA staff.

#### **WHSAA Rules of Play**

The class 2A Conference Golf meet shall consist of 36 holes of medal play- 18 holes on Friday and 18 Holes on Saturday. As per WHSAA Rule 7.868, in case of a tie in the team event (1st, 2nd, or 3rd) or in case of a tie for first place in the individual standings, the tie will be broken by a sudden death playoff.

## Team playoff procedures:

Playoff will begin on hole #10. If still tied, hole would be #9 until broken. Draw for tee box honors. Alternate between teams until all players have taken their drive. All five players from each team will play the hole with the best four scores (boys) or three scores (girls) used to break the tie. If a tie still exists, continue on the next hole until the tie is broken.

## Individual playoff procedure:

Playoff will begin on hole #10. If still tied, hole would #9 until broken. Draw for tee box honors. In the event of a tie, players will continue until the winner is determined.

## **Coaches Supervising on course of Play:**

As per WHSAA Rule 7.8.83, golf coaches are allowed to supervise on the golf course during play. This supervision and assignment is the responsibility of the Meet Director. There shall be a minimum of one adult monitor per hole at the State Meet. Coaches will not be allowed to play during the Conference meet.

The USGA rules shall prevail in the State Golf Meet. Please refer to the 2024-2025 WHSAA Handbook, pages 48-51 for WHSAA Golf Rules and Regulations. Local rule sheets will be provided by the host site.
