Game Day Rosters:

No more than twenty-two (22) players can be in uniform for any post season tournament contest. The twenty-two players, whose names are entered on the official roster for the tournament contest, shall be the only players used for the entire tournament. Violation of this provision shall cause forfeiture as per WHSAA Rules 5.0.7 and 1.4.0.

Hospitality Room:

A hospitality room will be provided for officials, coaches, and workers at all locations.

Lightning/Weather: update

Should there be inclement weather, the gyms at Thunder Basin and Campbell County and/or team buses will be used for shelter. At Energy Capital Sports Complex, buses and vehicles will be used for shelter. All players, coaches, and spectators must exit the venues if directed to do so by event staff. No one is allowed to stay on the field(s), in the restrooms, or in the stands during a lightning delay. ThorGuard is used to determine whether or not a lightning delay is necessary.

Locker Rooms:

Locker rooms will be provided as needed and requested by coaches. If playing at Thunder Basin High School, please contact Mr. Mike Delancey to arrange locker room access. If playing at Campbell County High School or Energy Sports Complex, please contact Mr. Dave Plendl to arrange locker room access. No locker rooms will be available at Energy Capital Sports Complex. Please come dressed to play.

<u>Media:</u>

Media areas will be located in the press box at both Campbell County High School and Thunder Basin High School.

At Energy Capital Sports Complex, media should report to the site director for availability.

Merchandise:

Merchandise will be available at all three venues during the tournament and also available online on the WHSAA State Soccer website or by clicking <u>here</u>.

Practice Fields:

Practice fields will be available beginning at 3pm on Wednesday, May 21, 2025. You may sign up for practice times <u>here</u>. (Please click on the "State Soccer Practice Field Schedule" tab at the bottom of the sheet.) Practice fields will be available at all three competition sites as well as Gillette College.

Spectator Parking:

Campbell County High School - spectators can park in the lot on the east side of the football field or in either lot on the west side of the high school.

Energy Capital Sports Complex - spectators can park in the lot on the north side of the fields or the west side of the softball fields.

Thunder Basin High School - spectators can park in the lot on the east side of the high school or the lot on the far west side of the high school.

Streaming:

All games at all sites will be streamed live via NFHS Network.

Uniforms:

Teams listed on the top of the bracket will be designated as the home team for the game and will wear their dark colored uniforms, with the exception that Thunder Basin High School will always sit on their home bench when playing at Thunder Basin, and Campbell County High School will always sit on their home bench when playing at Campbell County.

Videotaping:

Videotaping can be done from the press box at Campbell County High School or from the press box at Thunder Basin High School. Video taping can be done from the sidelines at the Energy Capital Sports Complex.

Warm Up Fields:

Grass fields will be available for pre-game warm-up adjacent to the game fields at Thunder Basin and Campbell County. At Energy Capital Sports Complex, teams will each have one-half of the non-game turf field to warm up on.
