#### **TOURNAMENT RULES**

Rules established by the United States Tennis Association shall prevail except where modified by the WHSAA. Once play has begun in a match, it will be continuous with no breaks unless permitted by the referee (site director). The site director shall have authority to appoint service and line officials as deemed necessary.

#### **SEEDING**

The top 8 schools will be seeded in each bracket. Priority will be given to those schools who have won the most league matches in that bracket. We will "seed" 1-8 for the South Region. Seeding will be completed by Wednesday evening, September 18<sup>th</sup>. You will be emailed the seeding results and will have 24 hours to communicate any seeding concerns. The seeding will be considered FINAL Thursday, September 19<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am.

#### **COACHING**

Coaching may take place before the match or within the ten (10) minutes between the second and third sets of split sets. Coaches are reminded that they are responsible for their team's actions on and around the court and also the actions of any spectators from their respective schools. Do not intentionally interrupt concentration or play in any way. Players may receive coaching from coaches or designated players with the number of persons coaching limited to two persons per site. (WHSAA Rule 7.13.33)

#### WARM-UP and MATCH PLAY

All locations will begin play at 8am. A ten (10) minute warm-up will be given starting at 7:50am. Athletes will be informed as to the next available court when it opens up. Once the players have been informed that a court is open, they will have no more than 10 minutes of warm up on the court. Athletes will be given thirty (30) minutes between back-to-back matches. Sight supervisors are instructed to keep the play moving.

Only first round matches each day will be assigned court location and starting times. All other matches will not be assigned to specific courts and times. Athletes should be ready to play as courts become available. Players need to keep track of speed of play at the location they are assigned. It is the players responsibility to be ready when the court becomes available. Players must check in personally with the site director in advance of playing time and be ready to play. Default is the penalty for failure to report. The hope is to get through everything but the consolation championships and the championship matches on Friday. This will leave a total of 20 matches on Saturday weather permitting. Championship Matches will be played at Green River High School (begins @ 9am) and all Consolation Championship matches will be played at Lincoln Middle School (begins @ 8am)

#### **WINNERS**

The winner of a match must win two (2) out of three (3) sets. Sets that are tied at 6-6 will employ a tie-breaker (12-point tiebreaker) with the first team/player to reach 7 points, win by two.

#### **AWARDS**

All-Conference awards will be provided by the Wyoming 4A League and all Regional awards will be provided by the WHSAA.

- ➤ Plaques presented to Boys Team Champion and Girls Team Champion
- ➤ All Conference medals presented to First and Second place finishers in #1 Singles, #2 Singles and #1 Doubles

### **4A League By-Laws Applying to Tennis:**

#### **9.10 TENNIS**

- a. All Wyoming High School Activities Association rules will prevail for the conference tournaments and matches.
- b. All conference teams shall participate in all scheduled conference dual matches plus the Conference Championship Tournament.
- c. School day matches shall begin at 4:00 p.m. and weekend matches shall begin at 9:00 a.m. unless otherwise agreed upon by both schools.
- d. The Conference Awards for both boys and girls teams and individual players, determined by conference dual records will be a team championship plaque, medals for the top two singles in Division I, top two singles in Division II, top two doubles players in Division II, Top two doubles players in Division III.
- e. When seeding for Conference Tournament, the #1 seed of the tournament does not have to take an automatic bye, but be given the choice to defer the bye to the #2 seed.
- f. At the Conference Tournament the points for the #3 Doubles should be the same as those established for the State Tournament.
- g. In conference matches both coaches shall make their lineup list prior to a match. This list will certify that the squad's best tennis player, which has been determined by play, will represent the team and play #1 singles. The coach at his/her option may play the #2 player at either the #2 singles position or at the #1 doubles position.
- h. The doubles team may be any combination of squad members after the two best players have been designated. However, as determined by play, the #1 doubles team must be the squad's best doubles team. The #2 doubles team will be the second best doubles team. The #3 doubles team will be the third best doubles team. No player will be allowed to play both singles and doubles in any conference match or tournament.
- i. No player may drop more than one position per league match.
- j. Substitutions: During season play, direct substitution may be allowed by a lesser-ranked player if the original player, because of injury or illness, becomes unavailable.
- k. Tennis Etiquette: Tennis etiquette will be strictly enforced. Proper tennis attire, which excludes jeans, cut-off jeans, and the like, is mandatory. Team shirts will be worn that are appropriate as a member of a school team uniform. The two coaches or the tournament director will deal with improper language or



other acts that detract from the game of tennis. Disciplinary action could result in forfeiture of a game, set, or match.

- I. Coaching may take place before the match or within the ten (10) minutes between the second and third sets of split sets. Coaches are reminded that they are responsible for their team's actions on and around the court and also the actions of any spectators from their respective schools. Do not intentionally interrupt concentration or play in any way.
- m. The suggested maximum time for rest between split sets is ten (10) minutes.
- n. Warm-up time for the start of a match will be ten (10) minutes from the time the match director presents the players with the new balls.
- o. The winner of a match must win two (2) out of three (3) sets. Sets that are tied at 6-6 will employ a twelve (12)-point tiebreaker.
- p. In the event of inclement weather or limited time factor, competing teams may agree to shorten the matches when mutually agreed upon.
  - a. Suggested options:
    - 1. Play one Pro-set
      - a. First one to win 8 game pro-set with tie breaker at 8 games all.
      - b. All tie breakers will be a seven-point tie breaker, must win by two (2) points.
