HEAD COACHES MEETING

The Head Coaches meeting will be at 6:30 pm Thursday, September 17th at Campbell County High School in the Commons. Playing times, locations, and instructions will be reviewed.

TOURNAMENT RULES

Rules established by the United States Tennis Association shall prevail, except where modified by the WHSAA. Once play has begun in a match, it will be continuous with no breaks unless permitted by the referee (site director). The site director shall have authority to appoint service and line officials as deemed necessary.

SEEDING

All schools will be seeded in each bracket. Priority will be given to those schools who have won the most league matches in that bracket. If a tie occurs, the tournament director will use the following tie breaking criteria:

1. Head to head competition on a two way tie.
2. One school beating others on a three way tie and then head to head competition between the other two.
3. If the tie still exists or cannot be decided with the criteria above, the USTA Friend at Court Handbook of Rules and Regulations, tie breaker procedure will be used to determine the outcome. USTA Regulations II.b.6(c).
4. Coin flip, odd school receives lowest seed and then head to head with others.

SEEDING PLACEMENT

The number one and four seeds will always be in the same half of the bracket. The number two and three seeds will always be in the same half of the bracket.

COACHING

During the Regional Tournament, coaches can coach between points and any breaks of play so long as the coaching does not interfere with play. Coaching is not allowed on changeovers. Coaches' comments can only be directed at their players and not at the opposing player when the coach is on the same end as their player. Coaching may also take place before the match, or for 2 minutes at the end of set one, or within the (10) minutes between the second and third set of split sets. Players may receive coaching from their coaches and/or teammates with the number of persons coaching limited to two per visit. (WHSAA Rule 7.13.33)

WARM-UP

A ten (10) minute warm-up will be given before the first match. After that, five (5) minutes will be given. Athletes will be given thirty (30) minutes between back-to-back matches.

RESTROOM BREAKS

Play should be continuous, but the site director has the authority to grant restroom breaks as needed between sets or during odd-game changeovers in an emergency. In these rare instances, the player will be escorted to the restroom by the site director or designee.

MATCH PLAY

Only first round matches each day will be assigned court location and starting times. All other matches will not be assigned to specific courts and times. Athletes should be ready to play as courts become available. Players need to keep track of speed of play at the location they are assigned. It is the players' responsibility to be ready when the court becomes available. Players must check in personally with the site director in advance of playing time and be ready to play. Default is the penalty for failure to report within ten (10) minutes of court availability.

WINNERS

The winner of a match must win two (2) out of three (3) sets. Sets that are tied at 6-6 will employ a twelve (12) point tiebreaker.

AWARDS

All Conference awards will be provided by the Wyoming 4A League and all Regional awards will be provided by the WHSAA.

CONFERENCE AWARDS

- Plaques presented to Boys Team Champion and Girls Team Champion
- All Conference medals presented to First and Second place finishers in #1 Singles, #2 Singles and #1 Doubles
- All Conference medals presented to First place in #2 Doubles and #3 Doubles.

REGIONAL AWARDS

- Name plates presented to First, Second and Third place Boys and Girls Teams
- Medals presented to the top four finishers in each bracket.

COACH OF THE YEAR

Conference Girls Coach of the Year and Conference Boys Coach of the Year will be selected at the Regional Tournament. *Please turn in your vote by noon on Saturday, September 19 to Dave Plendl* This form is included with this packet.

TENNIS ETIQUETTE

In order to encourage better sportsmanship, tennis etiquette will be strictly enforced. Improper Language, racket abuse, and/or ball abuse that is witnessed by the site coordinator, official or that is reported to either the site coordinator or official by the offending player's coach shall result in loss of a point. A 2nd unsportsmanlike act will result in loss of a game and a 3rd act will result in disqualification/ejection. While the imposition of this penalty would be after the first offense, any flagrant unsportsmanlike act MAY result in immediate disqualification. If the unsporting act is directed at a competitor, coach, official, spectators, or tournament personnel, the penalty shall be immediate disqualification/ejection from the event. It is the expectation of the coaches to monitor etiquette during the regular season and report any disqualification to the WHSAA office. *A game penalty assessed during a set tiebreak results in loss of the set. If assessed during a Match Tiebreak, this results in loss of the match. (WHSAA Rule 7.13.32)

PARKING

There is a large construction project going on at CCHS. We have already hosted a couple of large events and teams, fans/spectators have been great about parking in designated areas. Please follow the parking instructions for both team buses and for fan/spectator parking. Please read and follow the maps.

To get to the Tennis Courts, turn east off of Highway 59 on Camel Drive which is in between the McDonald's and Jersey Mike's restaurants. Go east until you come to the front of CCHS. Take a right at the stop sign and you will see the tennis courts.

Team buses: you may drop off the teams at the Tennis courts. If you are one of the first three buses, you may park along the curb by the Tennis courts. If you are arriving after that, the team buses will need to park along 12th street on the inlet directly north of the current football field. There is a yellow line on the map. The bus will need to come back and pick up players as needed.

Team Buses: Do Not drive into or park in the new lot that is in between the Tennis courts and the turf field. That lot is for cars only.

Fans/Spectators: You may park in either the new lot that is in between the Tennis courts and the turf field or along the far west side of the upper lot. Please be aware that CCHS will be in session on Friday until 3:00pm. Do not park in Smith's grocery store parking lot. You would be running the risk of being towed and we don't want that to happen to anybody.

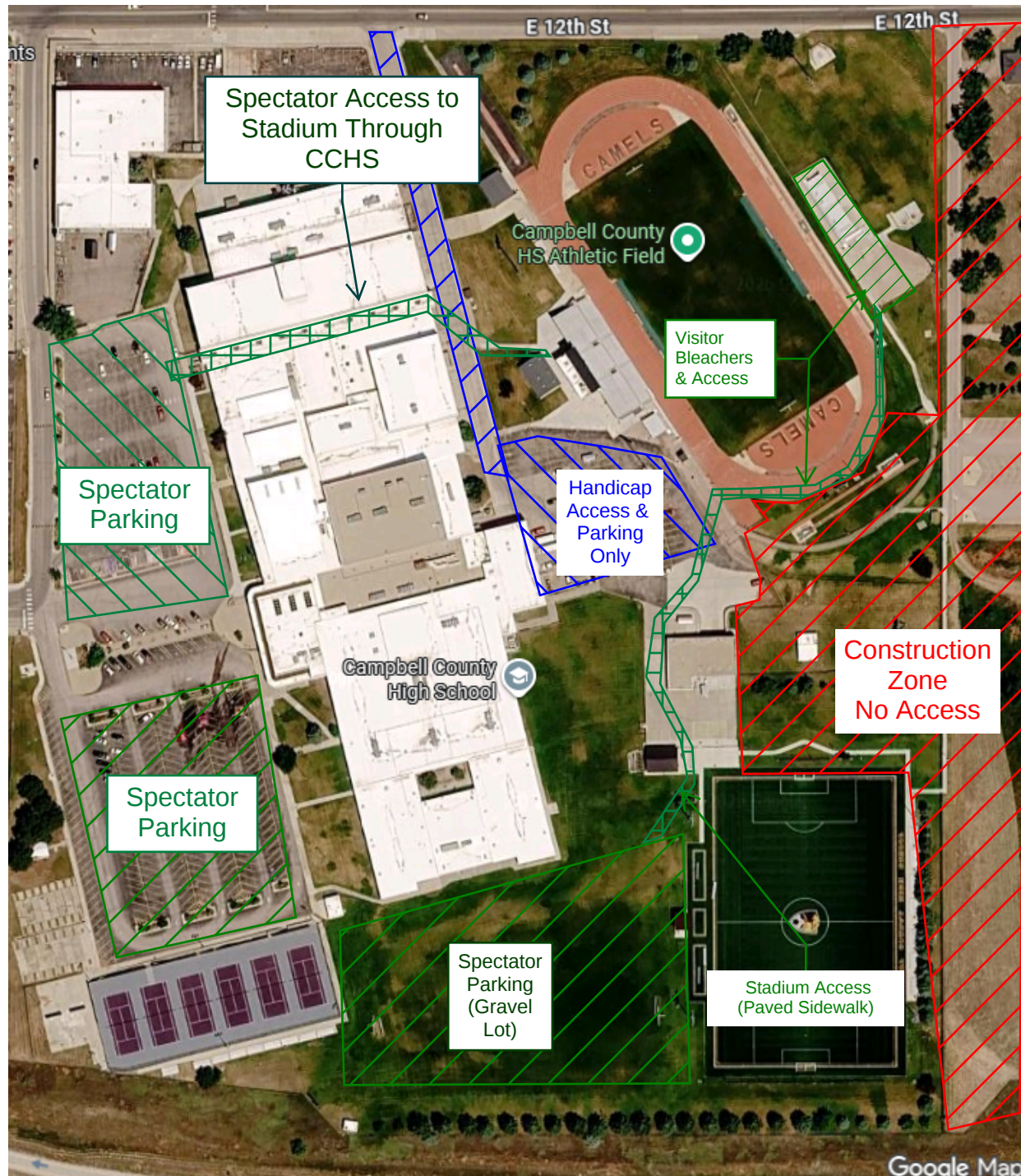
