Entries

All entries in the Regional tennis tournament will advance to the State Meet unless otherwise disqualified.

Hospitality

There will be hospitality available each day at all sites for coaches and officials.



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Parking:

Bicentennial:

Busses must park in the gravel lot north of the tennis courts. Spectators will be allowed to park in the east and south parking lot adjacent to courts.

Campbell County HS:

Bus Parking at CCHS will be by the curb next to the Tennis Courts. Spectator parking will be in the new, temporary lot directly to the east of the Tennis Courts.

Rec Center Field House:

Parent and fan parking is available on the East and South sides of the Field House. Team buses may drop off athletes and equipment on the North side of the Field House. Buses should park in the five (5) bus parking spots on the North side of the Field House, along College Dr. to the North of the Field House,

Thunder Basin HS:

Parents and fans will be able to park along the road west and south of the tennis courts or on the North and East sides of the school. Buses park on the North or East side of the school.

Pets

NO PETS ALLOWED AT ANY C.C.S.D. TENNIS FACILITIES! This includes all sites for the state tournament. Please communicate this to your families.

Restrooms

Restrooms will be available at all sites.

Scores will be reported from all sites to meet headquarters and updated as they arrive on the www.whsaa.org web site.

Tournament Bracket and Rules

Please refer to the WHSAA Handbook, pages 66-71, for tennis rules and tournament format. The rules, as established by the United States Lawn Tennis Association, shall prevail except where modified by the Wyoming High School Activities Association. Once play has begun in a match, it will be continuous with no break unless permitted by the referee. The default time is reduced to 15 minutes. Only tennis balls furnished by the WHSAA (Penn high altitude balls) may be used during the tournament. The referee shall have authority to appoint service and line officials as he deems necessary. The above format and rules may be altered at the discretion of the Tournament Director, i.e., weather conditions for expeditious conducting of the tournament as per WHSAA Rule 7.13.37.

Officials

Qualified officials will rotate between sites throughout the tournament.

State Tennis Tournament Rules and Regulations

- 7.13.32 Tennis etiquette: In order to encourage better sportsmanship, tennis etiquette will be strictly enforced. Improper Language, racket abuse, and/or ball abuse that is witnessed by the site coordinator, official or that is reported to either the site coordinator or official by the offending player's coach shall result in loss of a point. A 2nd unsportsmanlike act will result in loss of a game and a 3rd act will result in disqualification/ejection. While the imposition of this penalty would be after the first offense, any flagrant unsportsmanlike act MAY result in immediate disqualification. If the unsporting act is directed at a competitor, coach, official, [67] spectators, or tournament personnel, the penalty shall be immediate disqualification/ejection from



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the event. It is the expectation of the coaches to monitor etiquette during the regular season and report any disqualification to the WHSAA office.

- ◆ *A game penalty assessed during a set tiebreak results in loss of the set. If assessed during a Match Tiebreak, this results in loss of the match.

→ 7.13.32.1 Proper tennis attire, which excludes jeans, cut-off jeans, and the like is mandatory. Team shirts will be worn that are appropriate as a member of a school team uniform. In doubles, uniform tops must match for both players.

→ 7.13.33 During the regular season, coaches can coach between points and any breaks of play so long as the coaching does not interfere with play. Coaches comments can only be directed at their players and not at the opposing player when the coach is on the same end as their player. Also, coaching by the coach or designee may take place during the changeovers, not to exceed the 90 second limit. Coaching may also take place before the match or within the ten (10) minutes between the second and third set of split sets. Coaches are reminded that they are responsible for their team's actions on and around the court and the actions of any spectators from their respective schools. Do not intentionally interrupt concentration or play in any way.

At the regional and state tournaments Coaching may also take place before the match, or for 2 minutes at the end of set one, or within the (10) minutes between the second and third set of split sets. Players may receive coaching from their coaches and/or teammates with the number of persons coaching limited to two per visit. During the State Tournament, coaches can only coach before the match, or for 2 minutes at the end of set one, or within the (10) minutes between the second and third set of split sets. Players may receive coaching from their coaches and/or teammates with the number of persons coaching limited to two per visit.

→ 7.13.35 Warm-up time for the start of a match will be ten (10) minutes from the time the match director presents the players with the new balls.

→ 7.13.36 The winner of a match must win two (2) out of the three (3) sets. Sets that are tied at 6-6 will employ a twelve (12) point tiebreaker.

- ◆ A seven-point tiebreaker will be used when games reach 6-6. The serving order stays the same as it was during the set. One team must reach seven



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points and be ahead by two points to win the set.

→ 7.13.56 ALTERNATES DURING STATE TENNIS TOURNAMENT PLAY If a player is unable to participate in State tournament play, it will be possible to substitute the alternate listed on the WHSAA Tennis Entry Form during tournament play under the following criteria:

- ◆ The match being played would be defaulted if play had begun.
- ◆ The alternate would remain in the substituted spot throughout the remainder of that tournament.
- ◆ The original player would be allowed to replace their alternate from the Regional Tournament and participate at the State Tournament in the same position. The alternate would only be able to participate at the State Tournament in the same position they participated in at the Regional Tournament.
- ◆ The alternate names on the entry form may be changed for the State Tournament from what was submitted for the Regional Tournament.

→ Play will be continuous. One minute change over to towel off, get a drink, as long as you do not take over one minute to do so.

- ◆ **Continuous play after the 1st game in each set. This is not to be a one-minute change over.**

→ A player is allowed to take a Toilet/Change of Attire Break when an official determines that there is a genuine need. The player is allowed a reasonable period of time. When possible, the break is taken during a set break. If this is not possible, the break is taken at a changeover. Breaks taken at other times are limited to true emergencies.

Coaching is not allowed during this break by coaches, parents, other persons, or via electronics during this break.

→ One can of balls will be used for each match. The winner of the match has the responsibility to return the balls to the site director and report the scores.

→ No one is permitted on the court except the individuals that are playing.



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- If there are any major discrepancies over calls, a player may ask the umpire for assistance. **Officials on the court will only overrule an incorrect “Out” call if they are absolutely positive the call was incorrect.** Unfortunately, it is possible for a fan, coach, or player to have a better angle on certain line calls. Ultimately, it is the player’s responsibility to get the call correct and give the opponent the benefit of any doubt.
- Out and Let calls should be made immediately and audibly to prevent confusion. Server needs to call the score loud enough for the opponent to hear prior to 1st serves. Compliance with these two items generally prevents most scoring issues and confusion.
